

Red Wine cont'd

- 24 **Hardys 'The Riddle' Cabernet-Merlot,** £19.50
SE Australia - Australia (13.5% abv)
The velvety character of the Merlot complements the more structured Cabernet Sauvignon. Easy-drinking with soft tannins, a lingering finish and a light oak influence.
- 25 **Penfolds Private Release** £21.00
Shiraz-Cabernet Sauvignon,
SE Australia - Australia (13% abv)
Bright, deep purple red colour with spicy sweet blackberry lift, with a background of cherry and dusty oak. Medium-bodied with balanced tannins, the fruit flavours are dominated by blackberry and rhubarb.
- 26 **Don Jacobo Crianza Rioja Tinto,** £26.00
Bodegas Corral - Spain (12.5% abv)
A rich, full-bodied red made in the traditional way, with at least one year of oak ageing. It has a bright raspberry and cherry fruit character and a silky smooth finish.
- 27 **Fleurie Les Muriennes, Thorin** £32.00
France (13% abv)
The name Fleurie aptly describes the fresh, floral style of the wine.
- 28 **Châteauneuf-du-Pape Cuvée Tradition,** £40.00
Caves Saint-Pierre - France (13.5% abv)
Deep ruby in colour and very full-bodied, with a heady, spicy bouquet, ripe fruit and a long velvety finish.

Wines

Champagne

- 1 **Jacquart (% abv)** £35.00
Light and well-balanced with good maturity and a biscuity flavour.
- 2 **Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial (12% abv)** £48.00
A consistent, dry style with a distinctive flowery aroma. Yeasty character, a long, biscuity flavour and good level of acidity.
- 3 **Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut (12% abv)** £50.00
Rich and dry with great depth of flavour from this famous Reims house. Blended from a high proportion of Pinot grapes and aged for a mature, rounded character.
- 4 **Laurent-Perrier Brut L.P. (12% abv)** £52.00
Dry and lemony with a crisp, biscuity finish. Made using the three classic grape varieties, Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier.
- 5 **Jacquart Rosé (% abv)** £43.00
Lively, vibrant cherries and strawberries.
- 6 **Laurent-Perrier Cuvée Rosé Brut (12% abv)** £60.00
Flowery, fragrant and dry with soft mousse, rich and complex. Delightful, fruit-scented bouquet.

White Wine

- 7 **Vita Chardonnay-Pinot Grigio del Veneto** £12.50
Italy (12% abv)
Excellent, fresh, rich fruit Chardonnay balanced by the natural pear drop finish of the Pinot Grigio.
- 8 **Fortant Sauvignon Blanc, VdP d'Oc** £15.50
France (12.5% abv)
Picking at night retains the freshness of the Sauvignon Blanc grape. Lively and crisp with citrus and pineapple notes.
- 9 **Berri Estates Unoaked Chardonnay, SE Australia - Australia (13.5% abv)** £18.00
A crisp style with a fresh, yet ripe lemon character with no oak ageing.
- 10 **Bolla Pinot Grigio delle Venezie** £20.00
Italy (12% abv)
Dry with ripe peachy fruit flavours, hints of figs and excellent length.
- 11 **Kleine Zalze Bush Vines** £19.00
Chenin Blanc, Stellenbosch - South Africa (13.5% abv)
Soft and creamy with a hint of ripe tropical fruit on the finish and a delicious vanilla sweetness from the oak.
- 12 **Hardys 'The Riddle'** £19.50
Chardonnay-Semillon, SE Australia
Australia (13% abv)
A popular blend, combining a soft creamy texture with lime flavours and subtle oak characters that deliver a crisp dry white wine.
- 13 **Villa Maria Private Bin** £27.00
Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough
New Zealand (13.5% abv)
Herbaceous and flavoursome from this world renowned estate. The palate is lively and intense, with mouth-filling, tropical fruit flavours.

- 14 **Chablis, Paul Deloux** £35.00
France (12% abv)
Flowery, lively, fresh and mouth-watering with a crisp fruity palate and that flinty backbone only found in true Chablis.
- 15 **Sancerre Les Collinettes, Joseph Mellot** £38.00
France (12.5% abv)
A stylish, crisp Sauvignon with the tell-tale aroma of gooseberries and powerful fruit flavours, linked with a clean finish.
- 16 **Puligny-Montrachet, Louis Jadot** £70.00
France (13.5% abv)
From one of the top villages on the Côte de Beaune, Jadot's wine is rich and oaky with good underlying fruit and balancing acidity, it is very stylish and elegant.

Rosé Wine

- 17 **Corte Vigna Pinot Grigio** £20.00
Rosé delle Venezie - Italy (12% abv)
Off-dry, light and fresh with attractive fruit flavours of strawberry and morel cherry. A delicate pink hue from brief contact with the skins.
- 18 **Don Jacobo Rioja Rosado,** £22.50
Bodegas Corral - Spain (12.5% abv)
A delightfully deep-coloured rosé from Spain's premier wine region, with a fresh summer fruits nose and a lively, zingy palate.

Red Wine

- 19 **Vita Merlot-Cabernet del Veneto** £12.50
Italy (12% abv)
Soft bilberry fruit balanced by the tannins of the Cabernet Franc varietal. Using a blend of Merlot and Cabernet with extended fermentation in stainless steel to extract colour and forward jammy fruit.
- 20 **Fortant Merlot, VdP d'Oc** £15.50
France (13% abv)
Produced in the south of France using 'New World' techniques to produce a soft, fruity wine.
- 21 **Berri Estates Shiraz, SE Australia** £18.00
Australia (13.5% abv)
Medium-bodied and fruity with blackberry and cherry aromas. Red pepper, coffee and toasted vanilla flavours combine to provide good complexity on the palate.
- 22 **Côtes du Rhône La Dentelière,** £20.00
Caves Saint-Pierre - France (13% abv)
Easy-drinking and medium-bodied, from the sunny Rhône Valley. A ripe fruit taste with a hint of pepper reflecting the warm climate and traditional Rhône grape varieties.
- 23 **Kleine Zalze Pinotage, Stellenbosch** £20.50
South Africa (14.5% abv)
A deep-coloured wine made from South Africa's 'own' grape variety. Excellent berry fruit flavours and soft tannins from vineyards located in the beautiful region of Stellenbosch.
